Who are we? By the numbers


- Over 31,000 facilities in the 50 states and the four US territories.
- About 600,000 employees.
- Over 200,000 vehicles.
- Handle over 40% of the world's volume of mail.
- Nearly 1 million delivery points added per year.



- Mail is moved via planes, trains, trucks, boats, ferries, helicopters, subway, float planes, hovercraft, T-3's, streetcars, mules, bicycles, and feet.
- Offices range widely in size (smallest is 8" X 7")
- Fuel used includes electricity, gas, wood, and coal.
