- Draw on expertise from wide spectrum of sources including government, academia and industry



Strategic Alignment

- Implementing the Section 13 Report
- Guided by FAS Sustainability Theme
- Aligns initiatives with performance goals and measures
 - E.g. High Priority Performance Goal
 - 60 small companies do GHG inventory by end of FY2011



Implementation

- Interagency Working Groups (§ 13)
 - Training, Business Case, Eco-labels, Communications, Harmonization, & IT Systems
 - Membership completed by end of November
- Industry & Academic Roundtable (§ 13)
 - First meeting Nov. 4



Implementation (cont.)

- GHG Emissions Inventory Pilot (HPPG) (§ 13)
 - Top 200 & CDP
 - 60 Small Businesses
- Sustainability in Procurement Fellowship (SPF) (§ 13)
 - Cohort-based sustainability leadership program



Implementation (cont.)

- Sustainability in Acquisition training (§ 13)
 - GSA Online University & Center for Acquisition Excellence courses launch Q1 FY11
 - FAS providing support to FAI course
- GSA Green Purchasing Plan (§ 13)
 - 1st GSA acquisition policy action related to EO

Implementation (cont.)

- “Hotspots” and Prioritization Study (§ 13)
 - Product category with (1) most federal spend, and (2) worst environmental impact
- First implementations of GHG emissions information in a federal procurement (§ 13)
 - IT Commodities, furniture, FSSI.....
