Common Violation #1: Hazardous Waste Determination

- Waste Types
 - Characteristic (D waste codes)
 - Listed (F, K, P and U)
- Hazardous waste determination
 - Analytical test results
 - Process knowledge
- What documentation is required for a waste stream to be characterized?



Common Violation #2: Generator Status

- Generator category
 - Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) less than 100 kilograms (kg) per month
 - Small Quantity Generator (SQG) between 100 kg and 1000 kg per month
 - Large Quantity Generator (LQG) greater than 1,000 kg per month
- Failure to obtain hazardous waste generator ID
- Operating under an incorrect generator classification



Common Violation #3: Use and Management of Containers

- Satellite Accumulation/Storage Areas
 - Failure to label/date
 - Failure to close containers
 - Satellite to satellite transfer
 - Store waste for greater than permitted times/volumes



Common Violation #4: Use and Management of Containers

- Central Accumulation/Storage Areas
 - Failure to label/date drums
 - Failure to close containers
 - Storage for greater than 90/180 days

Common Violation #5: Records

- Weekly inspections
- RCRA specific training
- Contingency plan
- Emergency procedures
- Waste determinations
- Manifests
- Land disposal restriction forms



Common Violation #6: Hazardous Waste Manifests

- Failure to complete (shipping on bills of lading)
- Failure to use EPA ID number
- Signatures / dates
- Manifest discrepancies
- Exception reporting



Common Violation #7: Universal Waste

- Failure to demonstrate accumulation times
- Failure to have system in place to manage
- Failure to close containers
- Failure to label containers



Common Violation #8: Waste Treatment

- Evaporation/heat treatment/drain disposal
- Abandonment in place/orphaned chemicals
- Storage in lab hoods



Common Violation #9: Storage of Incompatible Wastes

- Failure to separate incompatible hazardous wastes
- Failure to provide protection between the incompatible hazardous wastes, such as a dike, berm, or wall
