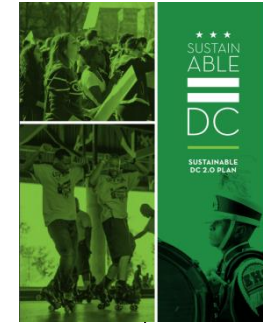

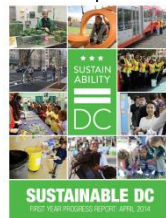

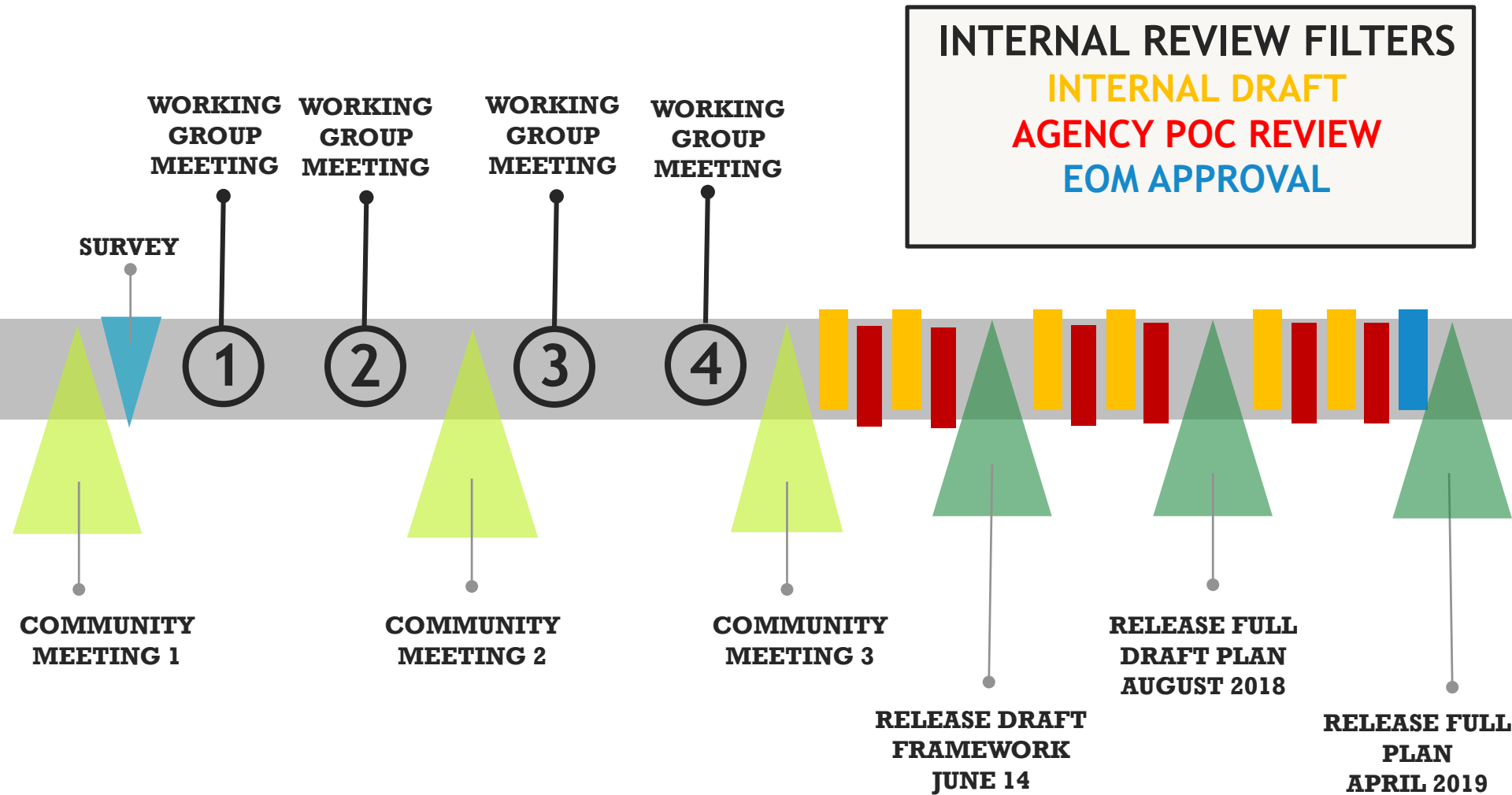

# TECHNICAL RIGOR

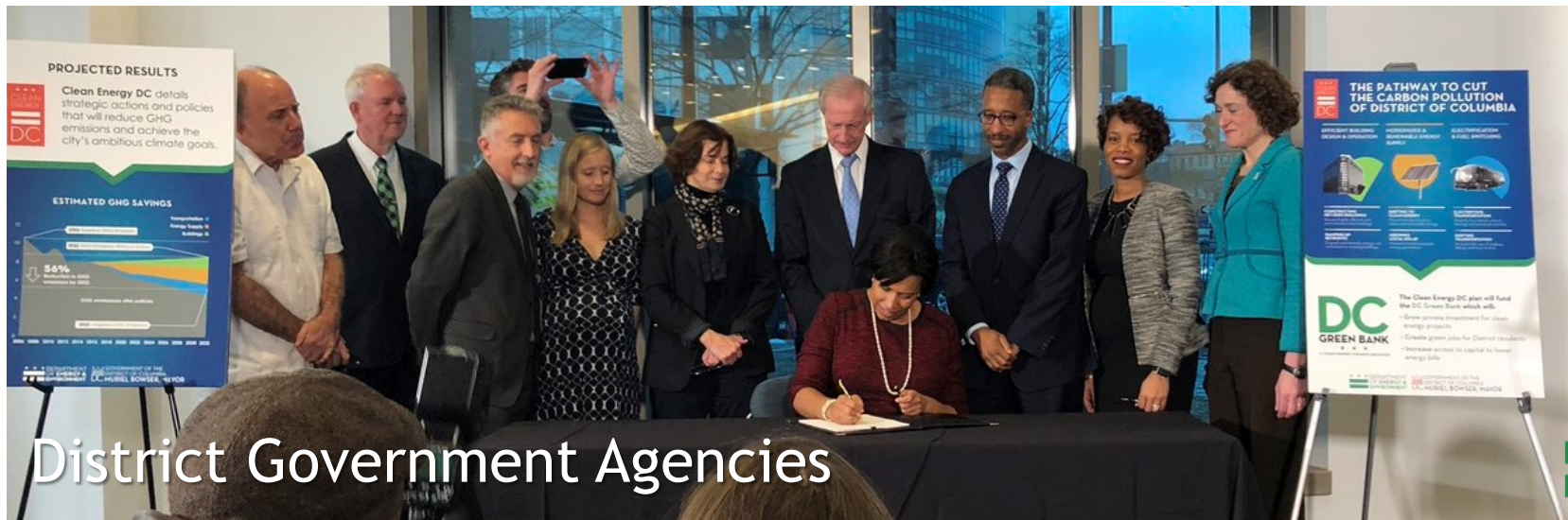
---

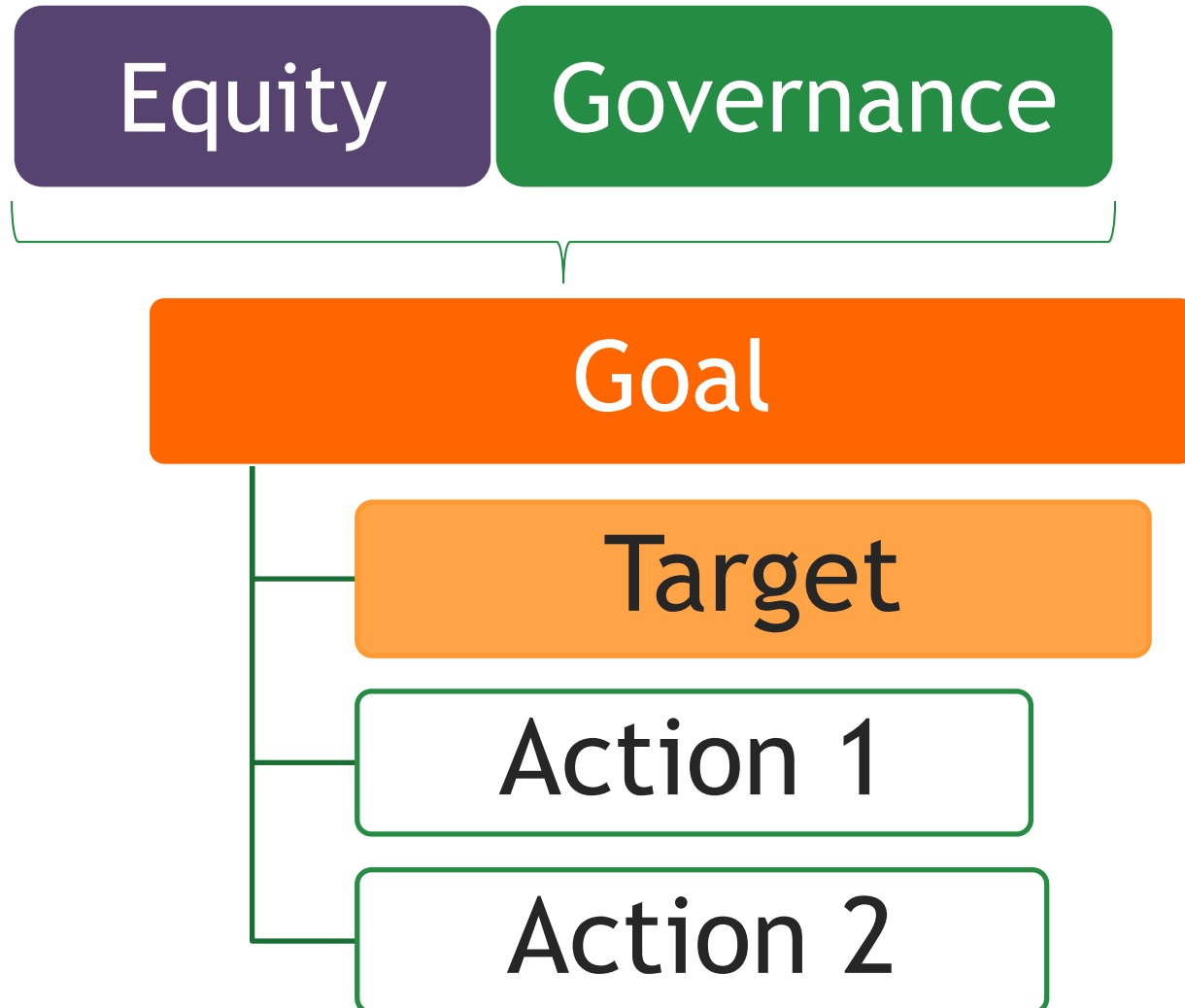

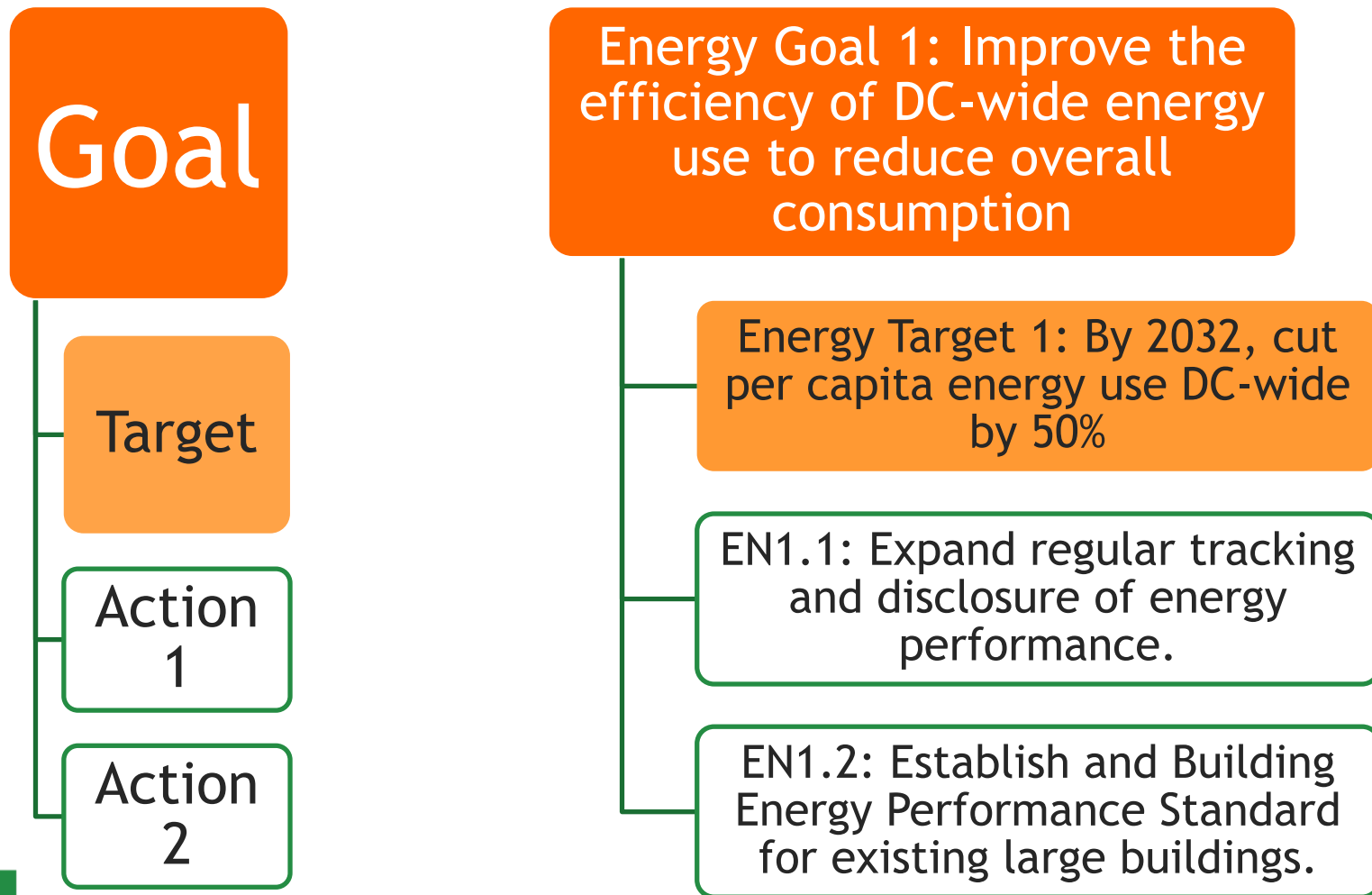

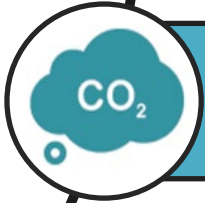
Goal 1: Improve the efficiency of DC-wide energy use to reduce overall consumption



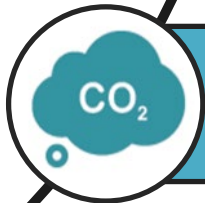
Goal 2: Increase the proportion of energy sourced from both clean and renewable supplies.

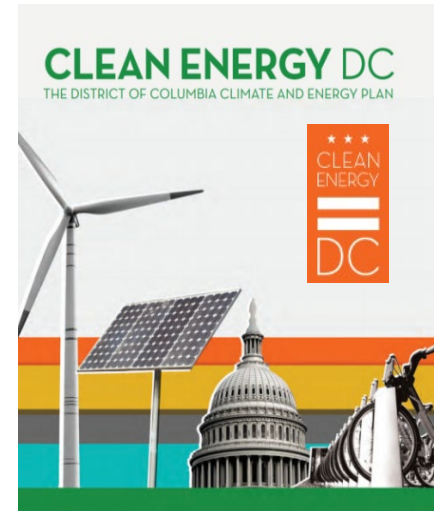

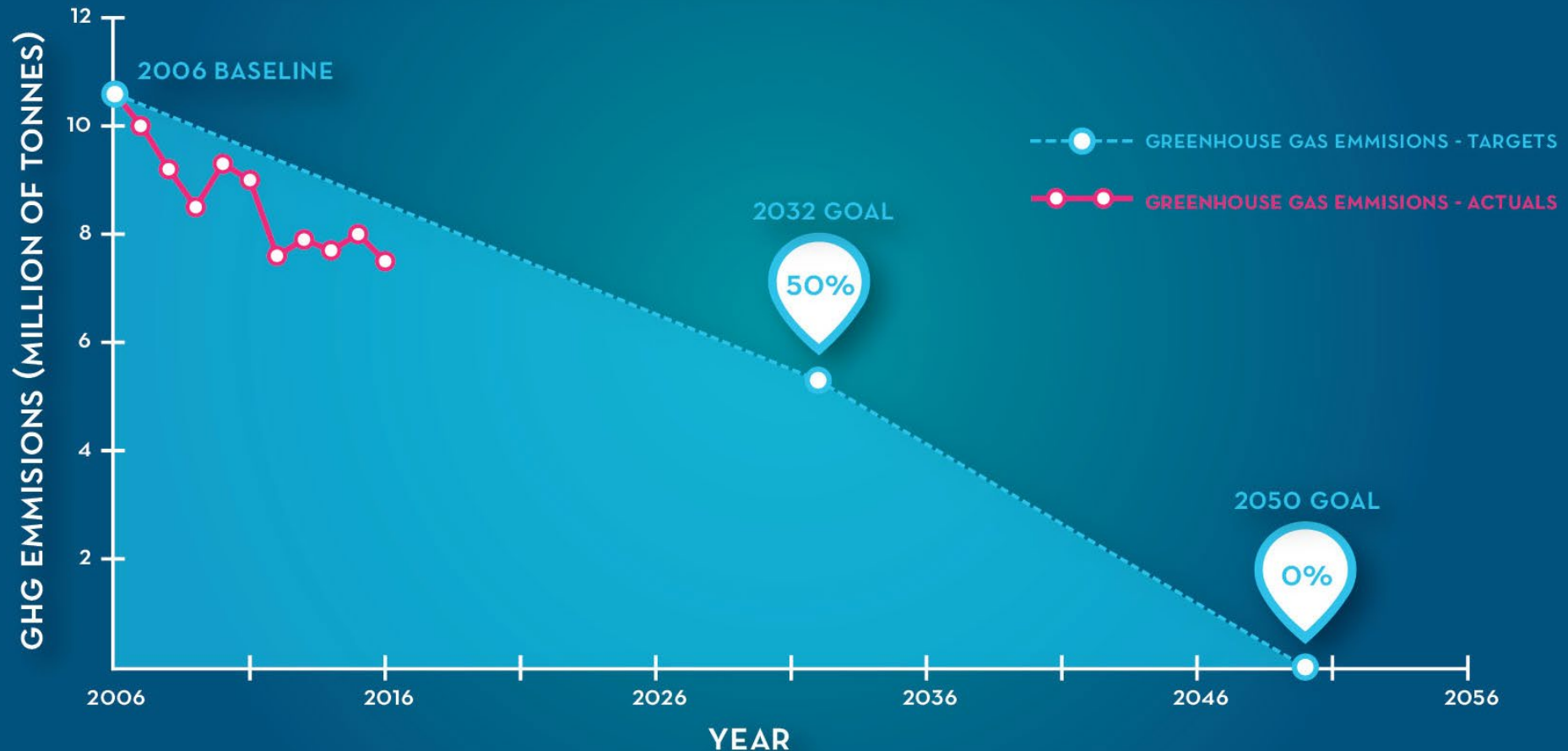

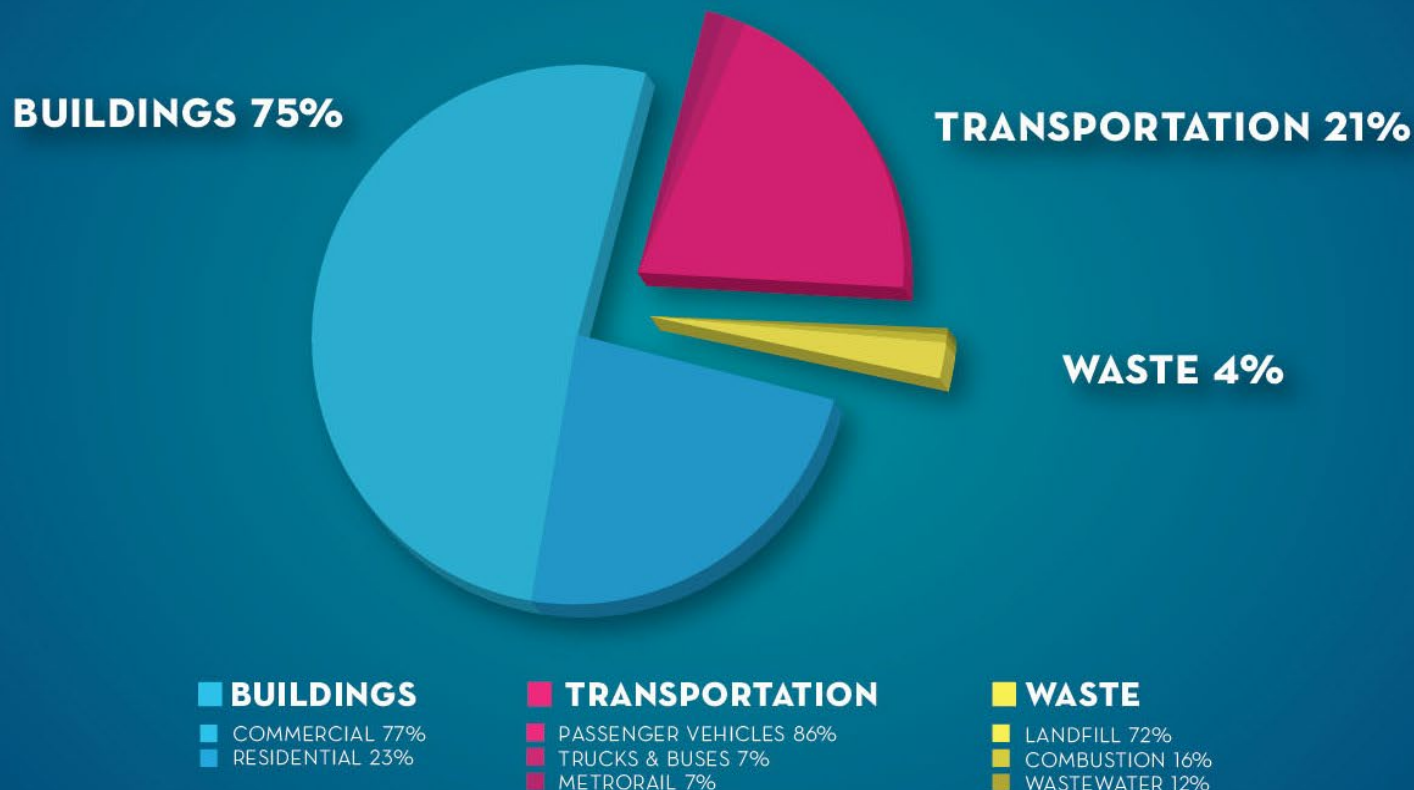
