






### PLAN DEVELOPMENT: SDC TIMELINE

### UPDATE OBJECTIVES

- Increase quantitative rigor
- Engage people in the planning process who weren't involved the first time
- Make sure every District resident sees their priorities and concerns in the updated plan





## TECHNICAL RIGOR

- Analysis of data inputs
  - 3,000+ survey
  - Focus groups
  - Telephone survey
  - Other District plans
  - Feedback from community meetings
- Screening matrix
  - Quantifiable?
  - On track?





Goal 1: Reduce greenhouse gas emissions from all local sources to put us on track to eliminate emissions by 2050.




