

Background

- Federal mandates establish requirements for federal facilities to improve their environmental performance
- EPA's Federal Facilities Enforcement Office (FFEO) desires to "get ahead of the curve" devises plan to assist federal facilities with compliance
 - > Envisions an independent, full service compliance assistance center, self-governed by the agencies it serves
 - Baseline set of services + fee-for-service activities
- EPA turns to CERL for their track record in regulatory expertise and management of information technology systems

FedCenter Management Team

- EPA's FFEO coordinates and leads the effort
 - Facilitates Board meetings, leads agency funding efforts and provides contractual/legal guidance
 - Provides subject matter expertise
- CEQ partners w/FedCenter for Executive Order policy & guidance distribution, interagency working group support,
 Administration initiatives
 - Federal Chief Sustainability Officer seat on FedCenter Advisory Board
- Governed by multi-agency Advisory Board
 - ➤ 16 agencies currently represented (DHS, DOE, DOI, DOC, USACE, USDA, EPA, NASA, DVA, DHHS, TREAS, DOJ, GSA, State Dept., USPS, and CEQ/OFS)
 - Meets quarterly to discuss, prioritize and provide guidance on FedCenter matters
- Operated and managed by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (ERDC/CERL)
 - Developed and deployed FedCenter.gov in FY2004





- FEDRPTS reporting tool
 - ➤ Helping Federal agencies manage their environmental inventories and comply with environmental reporting requirements
 - ➤ Initially used for EPACT UST reporting
 - ➤ Currently hosting EMS reporting, DOE GreenBuy Awards
 - > Customizable, secure, offered as fee-for-service to federal agencies

Resilience Week 2019 Symposium (San Antonio, TX) (11/04/2019 - 11/07/2019)

Resilience Week is an annual symposium organized by DOE's Idaho National Laboratory, where private and public partners discuss how they can work together to ensure a secure and reliable flow of energy across the nation. The strategically applied use of renewable energy can increase the resilience of distribution and transmission systems; however, it is important to consider all the aspects of resilience, including the most cost-effective and resilient integration of assets to adapt to and recover from natural disasters and cyber-attack. One of the projects to be discussed at Resilience Week is called Microgrids, Infrastructure Resilience, and Advanced Controls Launchpad (MTRACL), a WETO-funded project targeted at accelerating distributed wind technology development for increased microgrid resilience.

Air Emissions

AIRNow Mobile

The AIRNow mobile application provides you real-time air quality information that you can use to protect your health when planning your day. You can get location-specific reports on current air quality and air quality forecasts for both ozone and fine particle pollution (PM2.5). Air quality maps from the AIRNow website provide visual depictions of current and forecast air quality nationwide, and a page on air quality-related health effects explains what actions people can take to protect their health at different AQI levels, such as "code orange."

Transportation
